**Course Content:**

Create a painting that will encompass the uniqueness and wonder of myth and legend from Ireland. For those who want to try something a little different, embrace the challenge of painting an Irish Castle. The artist will render an old Irish Castle in the spring with a splash of wild flowers and perhaps reflections in a pond or stream.

**Supplies:**

Students are required to bring the paints that they have. Frisket, graphite paper/tracing paper, 200lb to 300lb water-colour paper, all your brushes, a board to affix the painting (16" by 24"), paper towel, water bucket, tape, Saran Wrap, pencils, eraser, etc...
