

**Beginner Mixed Media**

**About the Instructor:**

Robbyn Moore is a graphic designer, who has worked in the graphic field, producing magazines, advertising and logos. Her interests have turned from graphic design to coloured pencil and painting. Robbyn regularly has paintings included in the Annual Lindsay Gallery Juried Show.

**Course Content:**

Learn how to use mixed media techniques to create unusual and interesting art pieces with a more abstract contemporary look and feel. Techniques include creating textures, photo transfer and applications of various papers.

First night - explore different mediums i.e. photo transfers, applying tissue paper, newspaper, cheesecloth and applying the modelling paste and using a brush or knife creating textures. Make a small canvas as an experiment. Which will need to dry until next class. I think it is better to get some experience with the textures before going on to larger, more permanent painting.

Second night - start applying paint to small experiment canvas from last week and again any other materials (provided). Apply modelling paste to larger canvas, which needs to dry for next class.

Third night - work on paintings applying paint and any other materials of interest.

Fourth night - same as third.

**Material List**

Students will pay a 20.00 material fee, which would include the modelling paste, which gives texture and flat canvases to work on.

Students need to bring a variety of brushes and acrylic paints in colours they wish to work with.
