Course Content: The student will learn about materials, colour theory, compositions and execution of the watercolour medium. Several small vignettes will re-in force the student's new found knowledge backed up with handouts and take home notes.

Discover how fun and easy watercolour can be. This course will give you the tools and confidence to pursue this wonderful medium further.

Supplies:

A Starter Kit can be purchased from the Instructor for \$25 (\$40 value). The kit will include all you need for class, including paints, palette, watercolour paper, brush, foam core, sponge and a pencil.

Students should bring a water vessel, acrylic eraser, paper towels, painter green tape and an old toothbrush.

If you wish to purchase your own supplies, you will need:

Paints: Watercolour tubes—student quality will do.

Prussian blue, French Ultramarine blue, Sepia, Cadmium red, Cadmium yellow, Raw sienna, Burnt Sienna.

Palette: Plastic with individual wells and mixing surface and lid (Riceson's) or a large white plate will do.

Brushes: #6 and #8 round. Optional: ½" flat (acrylic), #4 rigger or liner.

Other: Pencil and acrylic eraser, paper towels, water vessel, kitchen sponge, old toothbrush, painters green tape

Paper: One sheet of good quality cold pressed watercolour paper 140 lb min. (approx. 11"X14")
