A Week of Pottery and Painting Led by Professional Artists

July 11—15, 2011

Monday and Tuesday, July 11 and 12—Pottery with Instructor June Goodwin

Hand building projects will demonstrate the techniques used in Pottery—slab, coil, joining and finishing. Students will decorate their pieces with underglazes, glazes or acrylics.

Wednesday, July 13—Acrylic Painting with Instructor Cindy Bell

Students will plan their design on paper, learn colour mixing using basic colours, and create one or two works of art.

Thursday July 14—Chinese Brush Painting with Instructor Charles Leung

Subjects will include flowers, bamboo, insects, dragonflies and butterflies. Students will also learn how to write their own name in Chinese.

Friday, July 15th—Morning—Pottery with Instructor June Goodwin

Final finishing of functional pottery from the kiln using paint, varnish, acrylics, etc.

Friday, July 15th—Afternoon—Art Show featuring Artwork created during the week, 3-4pm

Parents and Grandparents are invited. Each student will take home their week's artwork at the end of the art show.
